Dr. Summers has over fifteen years of process, environmental, and safety instrumented system (SIS) design experience. Dr. Summers is a US representative to the international IEC 61511 committee, is chair of the TR84.02 and TR84.04 committees and is writing a book on instrumented systems for CCPS. She is a licensed professional engineer in Texas. She has taught courses on the SIS standards to over 2500 process industry professionals worldwide.

She has written more than 50 papers on the subject of SIS. She is a recipient of the 2005 ISA Albert F. Sperry Award for her outstanding contributions and leadership in the specification, development, and implementation of safety instrumented systems for the process automation industry.
